Parliamentary Budget Office

The Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) is an independent and non-partisan department of the Parliament.

The purpose of the PBO is to inform parliament by providing costings of policy proposals and analysis of the Budget by:

- 1** responding to requests made by Senators and Members for costings of policy proposals or for analysis of matters relating to the budget
- 2** publishing and presenting information to enhance the public understanding of budget and fiscal policy settings
- 3** conducting and publishing research that enhances the public understanding of the budget and fiscal policy settings.

A costing is an assessment of the financial impact of a proposed policy change on the Commonwealth Government Budget.

A budget analysis provides information on current budget and fiscal policy settings and can include advice on the amount of money allocated to particular programs, the drivers of change between budget updates or distributional analysis.
